Funding is available for training your current or future workforce.



On-the-Job Training (OJT) - Job Link will reimburse a business for up to half of a new employee's wages during their training period.

Incumbent Worker Training - Trainings held at a business to upskill current employees, helping to avoid layoffs and filling otherwise vacant positions with internal applicants.

Notification  
(WARN)**

The California WARN Act requires covered employers to provide advance notice of plant closing and massive layoffs. Covered employers should continue to file a WARN even if you cannot meet the 60-day time-frame due to COVID-19.
